CALCULATOR GUIDE: We are now introducing the graphing calculator in the second semester of Algebra 1. Early introduction of this tool has several advantages including the opportunity to explore graphical concepts, learning to solve complex algebraic equations through several methods and increasing problem solving fluency and speed for the ACT and SAT tests.
