SUPPLIES ARE REQUIRED BY THE FIRST DAY OF CLASS

## ALL GRADES PreK thru 5th

1 package white copy/printer paper (500 sheets, #20)  
Backpack  
Reusable leak-proof/sweat-proof water bottle

## PRE-K LITTLE DANIELS

1 set of jumbo crayons (at least 8 basic colors)  
4 small glue sticks (Elmer's preferred)  
2 PlayDoh brand playdohs  
1 plastic 2-pocket folder  
1 container of baby wipes  
1 pair of blunt end scissors  
2 boxes of facial tissue  
1 bottle of **antibacterial** hand gel  
1 Lysol disinfectant spray  
1 Foaming hand soap  
1 Baking soda (biggest size you're able)  
1 pencil box (approx. 8X5X2)

## OPTIONAL BUT APPRECIATED:

1 bottle vinegar  
1 Jumbo popsicle sticks  
1 Mini popsicle sticks  
1 Package white cardstock

## BRING TO SCHOOL EVERY DAY:

Healthy Snack (no peanuts or sweets)  
We welcome special things like sleeping blankets, snuggling dolls, favorite stuffed animals, etc. (They help to bring a little comfort for the first few weeks.)

## BRING TO SCHOOL THE FIRST DAY:

1 pair blunt metal scissors (Fiskars preferred) labeled  
1 pink pearl eraser  
6 Elmer's glue sticks  
1 bottle liquid glue  
1 whiteboard eraser - labeled w/name  
1 pack Expo chisel tip fat dry erase markers (colors welcome)  
1 pack fine tip black expo markers (for white board work)  
2 Boxes 16-24 ct crayons labeled w/name  
1 Box sharpened pencils (ticonderoga preferred)  
1 bottle hand sanitizing gel

## FIRST GRADE

### Whole Class Use:

2 pink pearl erasers  
2 Elmer's glue sticks  
1 Elmer's white liquid glue  
1 package 4 count EXPO dry erase markers (thick/bullet tip)  
24 count box of crayons (Crayola preferred)  
16 count Crayola watercolor paint set  
2 containers 3oz of PlayDoh any color (PlayDoh brand preferred)  
2 black and white composition notebooks (7.5in. X 9.75in.) \*\*\*Do NOT get spiral notebooks  
\*\*\*No need for pencils  
\*\*\*No need for cleaning supplies/tissue  
\*\*\*No need for paper

### Personal Use:

\*\*\*Mark the following items with child's name/initials

1 pencil box  
1 set of 24-count colored pencils  
1 set of color markers  
1 pair of blunt scissors (5" or 6")  
1 bottle 2 oz antibacterial hand gel  
1 set of headphones that can be plugged in

2 plastic 2-pocket folders with brads

## SECOND GRADE

### Whole Class Use:

24 sharpened Ticonderoga #2 pencils  
1 bottle of Elmer's washable glue  
1 pack of fine tip black EXPO markers  
2 containers of Play-Doh brand play-doh  
2-4 Yellow Highlighters  
1 package white card stock paper  
2 containers of Lysol Disinfectant Wipes  
2 boxes of Kleenex  
1 bottle of 8 oz antibacterial hand sanitizer

1 bottle of Elmer's liquid glue  
4 packages notebook paper wide-ruled  
1 pair of scissors  
1 non bendable ruler with inches and centimeters - labeled w/name  
1 pencil box- must fit crayons, markers, scissors, colored pencils, etc)  
1 non electric pencil sharpener with lid - labeled w/name  
2 containers disinfectant cleaning wipes (no homemade wipes)  
2 boxes of Kleenex  
1 bottle 2 oz antibacterial hand gel  
NIV Bible (to leave at school) labeled w/name  
1 package of baby wipes  
4 packages of 3 x 5 notecards  
1 package of quart size ziplock bags (slider top)  
1 wide ruled composition notebook (for Bible journal)  
2 two subject notebooks (for science and history)  
1 small dry erase eraser (to keep at desk)

## FOURTH GRADE

### Whole Class Use:

- 24 sharpened #2 pencils - no mechanical pencils
- 4 EXPO dry-erase markers chisel tip
- 1 set of EXPO dry erase markers fine tip
- 4 Elmer glue sticks
- 1 bottle of Elmer's white liquid glue
- Last name A-K = 1 package white cardstock paper
- Last name L-Z = 1 package multi-colored cardstock paper
- 3 packages notebook paper wide-ruled
- 3 packs of notecards (3x5)
- 1 package of sticky notes
- 2 boxes of Kleenex
- 1 container disinfectant cleaning wipes (no homemade wipes)
- 1 bottle 2 oz antibacterial hand gel
- 1 package of quart size Ziplock bags (non-slider preferred)

  - A good eraser such as a [HI-POLYMER Eraser](#) or a [Sakura Sumo Grip Eraser](#)
  - 1 box of colored pencils (12-count or more)
  - 1 pencil sharpener with lid
  - 1 set of thin-tipped colored markers
  - 8 Elmer's glue sticks
  - 1 non-bendable ruler with inches and centimeters
  - 1 set of EXPO dry erase markers, black or colored
  - 1 pair of scissors
  - 1 small pencil box (approx 8x5x2)
  - 1 math compass
  - 1 clear math protractor
  - 3 packages baby wipes or disinfecting wipes
  - 2 boxes of Kleenex
  - 1 bottle of antibacterial hand gel
